**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This program is designed for pediatricians, family medicine physicians, PAs, APNs, physicians in training, nurses and other allied health professionals. This conference is designed to convey new perspectives on pediatric infections, pulmonary diseases and newborn care.

### **LEARNING OBJECTIVES:**

At the conclusion of this program, participants should be able to:

- Describe the differential diagnosis of abnormal chest imaging.
- Describe the evaluation of pediatric patients with abnormal chest imaging.
- Apply the principle of stewardship in the prescribing of antibiotics to patients in the ambulatory setting.
- Identify opportunities for quality improvement related to antimicrobial stewardship within their own practice.
- Describe recent NICU practice changes, including the use of total body cooling, non invasive ventilation and delayed umbilical cord clamping.
- Identify areas of change in management of patients in the NICU that may affect the care of patients in the ambulatory setting.
- Identify important infections in newborns.
- Describe some of the rare causes of abnormal pediatric chest imaging.
- Explain the common clinical presentations of Mycoplasma infection in the pediatric population.
- Evaluate and treat pediatric patients with Mycoplasma infection.
- Review the respiratory mechanics of pediatric obesity.
- Describe some molecular testing platforms used to identify potential infections.
- Apply appropriate testing strategies for respiratory and gastrointestinal pathogens.
- Diagnose Lyme disease clinically and know when to appropriately send laboratory tests.
- Effectively treat Lyme disease and counsel patients on expected outcomes and prognosis.
- Apply behavioral techniques to treat behavioral insomnia.
- Differentiate subtypes of behavioral insomnia.
- Describe typical parental stress reactions and means to cope with a sick child.
- Identify available resources to best support families facing a critical illness, including palliative care.
- Identify patients who should be evaluated for primary immunodeficiencies.
- Interpret screening diagnostics for specific primary immunodeficiencies.
- Define abnormal sleepiness in pediatric patients.
- Discuss the differential diagnosis and evaluation of sleepiness in pediatric patients.
- Identify who qualifies as a late preterm infant and the increased risks pertaining to a late preterm infant.
- Describe the changes in management necessary in caring for a late preterm infant.
- Identify key physical exam findings when evaluating the pediatric patient with fever and rash.
- Discuss evidence-based approaches to evaluation of the patient with fever and rash.
- Identify concerning cardiorespiratory symptoms during exercise.
- Discuss the evaluation of dyspnea and syncope during exercise.
- Appropriately treat and prevent influenza.
